The courses offered are taught in English and in most cases in online form. Please, be responsible and choose courses that are designed for your level of study i.e. a student of Bachelor's degree chooses from courses designed for Bachelor's degree etc.

The number of courses per student is not strictly limited by CTU. But we kindly recommend to students not to take more than 3 courses in one semester. Besides that, please, also consider your level of English relevant to their chosen course. Recommended English proficiency level is B2.

If you are interested in courses provided by partner's institutions and would like to enrol, please send an email to Ms. Andrea Vavrinova: andrea.vavrinova@cvut.cz and provide her following information:

- the title of course you are interested in,
- your personal CTU student number,
- your faculty and study program at CTU, which you are going to study in winter semester 22/23,
- type of study (BA/MA/PhD) for next winter semester 22/23.

The deadline for registration is **26 June 2022**.

If you like a course from the Course Catalogue that is offered by CTU, please, sign the course up during CTU enrolment period in KOS system as usual.

If a situation arises that you will not be able to finish the course (no longer able to follow the course), you must immediately inform the teacher, coordinator of the host institution and Mrs. Andrea Vavřinová: andrea.vavrinova@cvut.cz.

Recognition of credits for elective courses taken at partner universities depends on your study programme. If you have the possibility to choose from a package of elective courses in your study programme, in this case you will apply for recognition of credits from the foreign university to the Vice Dean for Studies of your department where you are studying. If your programme of study does not offer an elective package, the credits for successfully completed courses from the foreign university will be added as an extra credits to your studies and will also be listed in diploma supplement, including the name of the university where you studied the course.

By joining the EuroTeQ project, students automatically become members of the EuroTeQ community. As the ambassadors of EuroTeQ, they agree to answer a questionnaire.

I hope that you will find the updated EuroTeQ Course Catalogue appealing and that you will take an advantage of the opportunity to study virtually at prestigious European universities.
